# Critical Timeline;

## ▶ MIRIA Parcel & Business Reporting; July & August, 2020;

- PA Revenue website went live July 1. Parcel reports filed by parcel owners and businesses from July 1 to September 1.

- All parcel owners and businesses contacted by mail, phone & email where possible. Most were welcoming & supportive of MIRIA efforts.

- Total number of MIRIA Zone parcel owners and businesses was 109.

## ▶ Compliance;

- At our initial 2/13/20 meeting with PA Revenue, their MIRP Liaison lead our expectations that first year reporting would probably be in the 30%+ range.

- Given complications of the COVID19 crisis, face to face meetings generally were not available to MIRIA staff or our compliance consultant.

- Based on our information and belief, 102 parcel owners and businesses filed the required reports, for a participation or compliance ratio of 93.6%

# Critical timeline, continued

- September; - Address Quick Response Grant Requests
  - Complete & execute QRG agreements & fund grants
  - Follow-up meetings with grant applicants
- October/November - continue MIRIA efforts
- December, 2020; Deadline for PA Revenue reporting 12/1, December Board meeting, final approval of 2020 grant applications, submission of 2021 MIRIA budget, Deadline for funds transfer to MIRIA 12/16.
